
HEOP MISSION

To reduce the **child poverty rate** and the **rate of the uninsured** across all 18 counties of WNC by helping folks access affordable health insurance and tax credits.

We do this by assisting clients in enrolling in the Affordable Care Act and Medicaid, and by running an IRS VITA tax clinic where trained volunteers and staff do tax education, counseling, and prepare tax returns for low-income families.

Pisgah Legal has offices in Asheville, Brevard, Burnsville, Hendersonville, Highlands/Cashiers, Marshall, Newland, Rutherfordton, Spruce Pine and Waynesville.

TARGET POPULATIONS



Uninsured individuals and families who make between 100% - 400% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)



TAXES

Individuals and families who do not typically file a tax return due to low income, those who have never filed, are afraid to file, or do not realize they can and would benefit from filing

MEDICAID EXPANSION OUTREACH EFFORTS

Since PLS has been doing the ACA navigator work since 2013, we've kept a list of folks who've been in the Medicaid gap so that we could reach out when expansion happened.

WORKING WITH COMMUNITY PARTNERS

In counties where PLS didn't already have a presence, we relied heavily on community partners already assisting populations we were trying to reach.

- Food distributions
- Homeless shelters, transitional housing, jails
- Childcare centers, school systems
- DSS and health departments, community health centers
- Domestic violence organizations

GUS THE JUSTICE BUS

Pisgah Legal Services put the Justice Bus into service last summer to help in our outreach efforts to rural communities.

It has a desk with chairs, a TV, built in Wi-fi and everything else we need to hold an appointment from anywhere in WNC.



RURAL OUTREACH

- Rural communities can be hard to reach for a number of reasons:
- They lack internet connection, cell service, and may be harder to reach by traditional marketing strategies
- Appalachian folks can be wary of outsiders trying to "sell" them something. They can be wary of accepting government aid because of a long-held belief of self-reliance.
- Building trust is crucial to reaching rural communities




OUTREACH TO SPANISH SPEAKING COMMUNITIES

Connections for Effective Outreach:

- Schools: school counselors, school nurses, coaches, Backpack Programs, don't forget charter schools ©
- Tabling at the local health departments, FQHCs and DSS
- Attending local sporting events, ie. upcoming soccer and baseball games
- Justice Bus-going to remote parts of the county ie. hotels, foodbanks
- Connecting with local jails to reach inmates upon release
- Attending your local health council or committee
